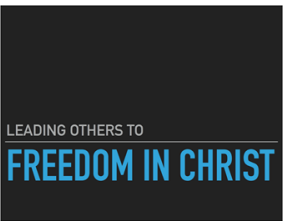

What Difference
Could *You* Make?

One couples’ willingness to
use Jesus’ Authority brings
healing to those with cancer.

Shane and his wife Missy were invited back to central Oregon to pray for a friend they’ve known since high school. Their friend, facing the last stages of terminal cancer, was given an estimated 2 weeks of life left to live. When they arrive at the hospital they discover about 12 family members crowded in the room crying and desperately hoping that some miracle would result from Shane & Missy’s visit. Feeling somewhat intimidated, Shane simply asks the Holy Spirit what Jesus wants to do. He then reads Ps 103 aloud and after hearing it their dying friend says that she is going to be healed because she claims the truth of the scripture he read. She also adds that she wants a hamburger when she’s restored! Shane then asks the husband to pray for his wife as he is an elder in a large Foursquare church there. As the husband begins to pray, Shane interrupts him to encourage and instruct him to pray with the authority Jesus has given to us for healing the sick. The husband then shifts from simply asking to using authoritative prayer. First he commands all fear to leave his family - which by their own testimony was replaced by God’s peace.

Then Shane simply *told cancer to leave, in Jesus’ name.*

Two days later the lady is walking around in her own home and a week later is eating a hamburger! There has been no sign of cancer for 6 months now.

Sometime later Shane returns to his hometown and shares this testimony with a woman who indicated her need for a heart valve transplant. Again, Shane prays *authoritatively* for her healing. The next day she goes to the medical center in Salt Lake City, nearly a 6 hour drive by car, to discover that her heart valve is 100% healed.

Another man in their hometown also suffering with cancer was prayed for and he too was healed! A former board member who sent us this wonderful testimony reported that he had just spent 2 hours with Shane who asked him to send his thanks to us at Kingdom Ministries for teaching him and Missy how to pray. He goes on to share that both Shane and Missy believe God is call-



ing them to move to another state and become part of a church where two years ago they had prayed with a man with terminal leukemia. He too was healed! This man, after one time saying he would rather have cancer than go bankrupt, was healed after he repented and renounced his negative declaration. Afterward, he began to heal over the next few months.

Our former board member and long-time partner in ministry writes: “I just wanted you to know that God’s work through you and Kingdom Ministries is spreading like wildfire and there is more to tell but will have to be another time.”

Let me ask, What difference could *you* make for others in need, whether they have an illness, need freedom, or salvation? And, what difference will *others* make when they understand and utilize the authority Jesus has given us to heal the sick, and lead others to freedom? This couple and many others have been impacted in some way through what God is doing through Kingdom Ministries. They’ve moved from hearing to doing; from learning to application; from belief to faith.

Your partnership and participation with us makes it possible for us to carry out our mission to equip and multiply others who are willing to continue Jesus’ ministry throughout the world.

The essential need for utilizing God’s Word, Christ’s authority, and the Holy Spirit’s counsel in life and ministry are often at the root of a less than fruitful ministry and victorious Christian life.

How to Pray for the Sick

Prepare the place—Begin with a prayer something like this to prepare the place you’re meeting: “*We (I) assert the Lordship and dominion of Jesus Christ over this place and the people who are gathered here. In Jesus’ Name, if there are any influences of Satan and the unseen powers of darkness we bind and forbid them from affecting anyone and from interfering with God’s purpose here. In Jesus’ Name we command you to go where Jesus tells you and to be subject to His will. We claim the fulfillment of God’s purpose here and in the lives of those gathered here. Lord Jesus, we invite Your Holy Presence to fill this place ...*”

Ask the Questions Jesus Asked—Ask those who are sick if they would like to receive prayer for healing. Ask them some questions Jesus asked, for example, “*Do you want to get well?*” “*What (specifically) would you like God to do for you?*” “*Do you believe Jesus is able to heal you?*” And, “*If Jesus is willing to heal you at this time, will you accept His healing now and in the way He chooses to bring it?*” If appropriate ask, “*May I place my hands on your shoulder as we pray?*” If the answers to the above questions are all “yes”, pray something like: “*We agree Lord Jesus, if this is what you desire to do at this time we accept your healing for*



(name) and say to (name of illness, etc.) be healed in the Name of Jesus Christ. We cancel your influence and effects and command you to leave now in Jesus’ Name. Come Holy Spirit, fill them with your presence and Light and completely restore every part of their being, in Jesus’ Name. Amen.”

*Ask them, “*what is happening, what they are experiencing and what thoughts are coming to mind?*” If necessary, “*ask Jesus*” to reveal anything that would keep them from experiencing His healing and freedom. And, *In Jesus’ Name (we) command anything hidden or hindering their healing to come into the Light of Christ and His Truth.* Again, after “asking Jesus” to reveal what is hindering their freedom or healing and using His authority *ask them what comes to mind and/or if there is anything they believe might be hindering their healing.* Listen, then begin to “test”, explore and resolve those things that are revealed in the Light of God’s Truth and through the counsel of the Holy Spirit. Continue and persevere until there is healing and/or peace.
